Rick Green is an award winning producer, director, writer and comedic performer who has made hundreds of innovative television, radio and stage shows including: History Bites, The Red Green Show, Prisoners of Gravity and The Frantics.

In September 2009, Global Television aired Rick's documentary about Adult Attention Deficit Disorder, entitled, *ADD & Loving It?!* The film follows the story of Canadian actor Patrick McKenna as he gets a formal diagnosis and decides to educate himself about what ADHD is, and isn't. The film won Rick the CAMH Foundation's 2009 Celebrity Transforming Lives Award - before it had even aired. The nomination stated, "In one hour this program will transform how Canadians view this disorder." Transforming people's view of ADHD and providing good information is the motivation behind TotallyADD.com which Rick launched in December 2009. TotallyADD.com is a resource and community for anyone affected by Adult Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.
