The Clinical Manager Acute Inpatient Psychiatry (AIP) is one of three managers collaborating to manage the AIP program which is currently located across two sites in Sudbury which currently has 62 beds. The successful candidate will have a focus on Quality and Risk Management practices along with daily patient flow in addition to regular Human Resources/Operations management of the unit. The role operates within a continuous improvement culture using Lean principles focused on improving work and care at HSN.

The successful candidate should have a four (4) year Bachelor's Degree with a specialization in a health-related field, from an accredited university. The candidate must hold a current Certificate of Registration in good standing with an applicable regulatory College. Candidates with a Master's Degree in a health-related discipline will be given preference. We are looking for a minimum of five (5) years' experience working as a Health Professional in an Acute-Care Mental Health facility and two years' working in a leadership/supervisory role, preferably in an Inpatient Mental Health environment.
