St Michael's Hospital, a fully affiliated teaching site for the University of Toronto, is seeking a full-time certified psychiatrist to work in our Inpatient Unit.

Through its strengths in research, clinical innovation and education and clinical services to both hospital and community, St. Michael's Hospital is a living laboratory committed to improving the health of marginalized populations and health systems, urban health, critical care/trauma, brain health and neuroscience, and translational research.

The Department of Psychiatry at the University of Toronto has one of the largest concentrations of faculty and students in the mental health field in the world (<a href="http://www.utpsychiatry.ca/">http://www.utpsychiatry.ca/</a>).

Clinical responsibilities include inpatient psychiatric care teaching and supervision of psychiatry residents and medical students with opportunity for additional clinical activities.

Applicants must hold an MD, and must be certified or eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Candidates should be eligible for full-time academic appointment in the Department of Psychiatry, University of Toronto.

This is an excellent opportunity to provide inpatient psychiatric care in a dynamic, multidisciplinary setting. Inpatient clinical responsibilities include leading an inpatient team (34 bed unit shared among 6-7 teams). There is a commitment to education through the teaching and supervision of psychiatry residents and medical students. The successful candidate is expected to participate in scholarship of teaching, education, research, innovation, quality improvement or creative professional activity.

The ideal candidate will have exemplary clinical and interpersonal skills and be a strong highly professional team player equipped to work in an active collaborative clinical environment and be dedicated to the highest quality of patient care.

Remuneration – OHIP billing and sessional stipend and academic funding. On-call duties are 1 in 30 approximately well supported by allied health staff and psychiatric residents and on-call stipend.
