

Inpatient/Outpatient Psychiatrist

St. Michael's Hospital

St Michael's Hospital, a fully affiliated teaching site of the University of Toronto, is seeking a full-time certified psychiatrist to support its inpatient and outpatient divisions in the Mental Health & Addictions Service.

Located in downtown Toronto, St. Michael's Hospital is a leading urban academic health science centre (<http://www.stmichaelshospital.com/>). Through its strengths in research, clinical innovation and education and clinical services to both hospital and community, St. Michael's Hospital is a living laboratory committed to improving the health of marginalized populations and health system equity, urban health, critical care/trauma and translational research.

The Department of Psychiatry at the University of Toronto has one of the largest concentrations of faculty and students in the mental health field in the world (<http://www.utpsychiatry.ca/>).

Applicants must hold an MD, and must be certified or eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Candidates should be eligible for full-time academic appointment in the Department of Psychiatry, University of Toronto.

This is an excellent opportunity to provide inpatient and outpatient psychiatric care in a dynamic, multidisciplinary setting. Inpatient clinical responsibilities include leading an inpatient team (34 bed unit shared among 6 teams), while outpatient responsibilities involve providing psychiatric assessment and management in collaboration with allied health care support. In both roles, there is a commitment to education through the teaching and supervision of psychiatry residents and medical students. On call duties are approximately 1 in 30 and well supported by allied health staff, psychiatric residents and a newly built (August 2018) mental health emergency services area. The successful candidate is expected to participate in scholarship of teaching, education, research, innovation, quality improvement or creative professional activity.

The ideal candidate will have exemplary clinical and interpersonal skills and be a strong team player equipped to work in an active collaborative clinical environment and be dedicated to the highest quality of patient care.

Remuneration is fee for service billing along with eligibility for AFP, sessional and on-call funds in keeping with psychiatrists in Ontario.
