

Located on beautiful Georgian Bay, Waypoint Centre for Mental Health Care is a 301-bed psychiatric hospital providing specialized inpatient and outpatient psychiatric care for the North Simcoe Muskoka region, and providing forensic psychiatric care for patients requiring a high secure facility. We offer assessment, evidence-based treatment and recovery-oriented rehabilitation in a rich interprofessional care environment across a broad range of needs including acute care, psychosocial rehabilitation and outreach, geriatric mental health, youth mental health, concurrent disorders, and care for adults with dual diagnosis.

**Waypoint is currently recruiting psychiatrists who are looking for locum opportunities. For acute psychiatric care**, there are opportunities on an ongoing basis, and we seek commitments of at least 2 week periods, and would consider 1 week for physicians who would work with us on a regular/repeat basis. **For inpatient psychosocial rehabilitation**, there is an opportunity from May 3, 2021 through January 4, 2022 we seek commitments of at least 4 weeks and up to 8 months. Compensation is in the form of an independent contract with a daily rate.

We are accepting expressions of interest by candidates who hold an MD or equivalent, certification in Psychiatry from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and licensure for independent practice from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Consideration would be given to a senior resident candidate with a restricted license.

We are additionally recruiting for permanent positions in the areas of child and adolescent psychiatry, inpatient forensic psychiatry, regional geriatric mental health services, and physical healthcare. For these positions, remuneration is salaried and very competitive, with comprehensive benefits including pension. Independent contractor arrangements are also offered.

Waypoint is located in the Town of Penetanguishene, on the shores of beautiful Georgian Bay, less than two hours from Toronto and approximately 45 minutes from Barrie. Outdoor recreational opportunities in all four seasons abound in this area of natural beauty. Golfing, curling, fishing, boating, hiking, snowmobiling are just a few of the fun things to do here. At Waypoint, we believe in maintaining a work environment where people find meaning, enjoyment, and professional growth in their work while balancing and integrating with other aspects of their lives.
