Located on beautiful Georgian Bay, Waypoint Centre for Mental Health Care is a 301-bed psychiatric hospital providing specialized inpatient and outpatient psychiatric care, as well as ECT, psychotherapies, and other specialized services for the North Simcoe Muskoka region, and providing forensic psychiatric care for patients requiring a high secure facility. Less than two hours from Toronto and approximately 45 minutes from Barrie, this area provides ample outdoor recreational opportunities year round. At Waypoint, we believe in maintaining a work environment where people find meaning, enjoyment, and professional growth in their work while balancing and integrating with other aspects of their lives.

Clinical Setting and Duties:

Waypoint is seeking a full time psychiatrist to provide community outreach and outpatient care throughout the North Simcoe Muskoka region. Our Mobile Treatment and Support Team is a skilled interprofessional team providing psychosocial rehabilitation and supporting patients living with severe mental illness to integrate into the community. Our Outpatient Assessment and Treatment Service provides consultative and episodic care in person and virtually, including seamless care after hospitalization. The successful candidate to join this team will contribute to the development of collaborative partnerships with primary care and community mental health providers. As such, travel in the Midland and North Simcoe Muskoka Region will be required to successfully perform duties.

Qualifications:

Independent certificate of registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Royal College certification or equivalent.
